The entrant must present their speech on the day of judging – from 2pm, Saturday 28th March, 2009.

The entrant must accept that the judges' decision of winners is final.

Why should you participate?

You will be learning about ways to overcome poverty in third world countries.

You will learn to research a topic, and prepare a passionate speech.

You will personally enhance your public speaking skills.

You will experience the gift of giving - all of the prize money will go towards helping the projects of the winners' choice, and will make a positive difference in the lives of disadvantaged peoples.
